At this time, we are excited to begin New Student Registration for the upcoming school year. In order to register your son or daughter for the 2010-2011 school year, please complete the following steps in the registration process:

- Attach a copy of each new student's birth certificate and baptismal certificate (if applicable) to the registration form.
- Submit the new student registration fee of \$150.00 per family, of which \$100.00 will be applied to next year's tuition.
- Return all registration forms and fees to the school office by the registration deadline, February 17, 2010. Please note: Late registrations may have to be put on a waiting list since some classes may reach a maximum class size.

Tuition for the 2010-2011 school year has not been finalized. The fee structure for kindergarten will be comparable to the tuition assessed in grades one through eight; however, family discounts do not apply to kindergarten.

In April, an acceptance packet with additional information will be sent to those who have been accepted for the 2010-2011 school year. However, please feel free to contact the School Office with any questions or concerns you may have regarding the registration process. Thank you for entrusting your child's education to us, and we are looking forward to another exciting year at Saint James School.
