**THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED TO THE CLASS OF 2018**

- In 2018, St. James School will graduate 69 students. These students will go on to further their education in high school.
- 24% of our students earned a score of 90% percentile or better nationally on the high school entrance exam. 8 students scored a 95% or better.

- 70% of the graduating class was offered scholarship funds.
- Twenty-eight students were offered scholarships to Mercy McAuley High School.
