THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED TO THE CLASS OF 2017

- In 2017, St. James School will graduate 77 students. These students will go on to further their education in high school.

- 65% of the graduating class was offered scholarship funds.
- Eleven students were offered scholarships to McAuley High School.

- 22% of our students earned a score of 90% percentile or better nationally on the high school entrance exam. 10 students scored a 95% or better.
